Post Treatment Care for Pixel

Day 1:

- Treatment area will sting/burn for 3-4 hours after treatment. Cold packs may be used to ease temporary discomfort.
- Area will look sunburned & red and will be tender to touch.
- Use a gentle cleanser with finger tips only and pat dry (do this once a day in the AM for the first 3 days and then twice a day after that AM/PM).
- Apply a thin coat of either Vaseline, Aquaphor, CU3 Post Laser Lotion, or Elta moisturizer as needed daily (do this through entire healing process).
- Contact the office if you experience any blistering or problems.
- Makeup can be applied as long as the skin is not ruptured and use mineral make-up only.
- Sun exposure is to be avoided for at least 3 weeks before treatment and then for the following 3 weeks.

Day 2:

- Red areas will begin to look bronzed/brown- could still have some red also.
- If skin is not irritated you may use moisturizer with sunscreen when going outdoors.
- If skin feels irritated, use Vaseline or Aquaphor only as needed throughout the day.

Day 3 and 4:

- Skin will start to flake & peel in some areas. Apply moisturizer as needed.
- Skin will feel rough to touch like sandpaper. This is normal. Do NOT PICK as it may cause scarring!
- Continue to use CU3 Post Laser Lotion for the next 7-10 days and ALWAYS apply sunscreen in the morning.
- If you have a history of fever blisters, you will need to take an anti-viral medication to prevent a breakout. Please call the office if you feel you are getting a fever blister.

In summary, you will have a sunburned appearance that will start to bronze. Face will have some peeling and will feel like sandpaper. It is important to moisturize during the entire healing process.
